


## Sorting Your Search Results

Once you perform a POPLINE search, you can sort results by two options. From the **Search Results** page, select a **sort by** option. Sort options include: **Most Recent** or **Relevancy**. **More information about sorting:**

- Search results can also be sorted by **Relevancy**. The more times a search term appears in a document, the higher the relevancy score.
- Changes to the default sort are not retained once a new search is performed. **Each new search will sort results by Most Recent.**
